

CALL FOR ENTRIES

The Chattanooga Chapter of the American Institute of Architects (AIA) is pleased to announce our second annual scholarship for 9-12th grade students in Chattanooga, TN to attend a design summer camp offered by the University of Tennessee Knoxville (UTK). The purpose of the scholarship is to provide students with an interest in architecture with an opportunity to attend a summer architecture camp hosted by a local college of architecture.

A minimum of ONE scholarship will be awarded and must be used during the summer of 2022. Additional scholarships may be offered as additional sponsorships are identified concurrently for this Call for Entries.

The 2022 Summer Design Camp offered through UTK will be held in person the week of July 10-16. Additional details about the camp may be found here: <https://archdesign.utk.edu/study/summer-design-camp/>

The application shall include the following:

1. Typed responses – no more than 100 words to each of the following:
 - a. Describe your interest in architecture. How has your life experience led you to wanting to pursue an architectural education?
 - b. What role do architects play in the community and culture? What parts of that role do you most easily see yourself filling?
 - c. What accomplishments are you most proud of?
2. Provide an image of an original work created by the applicant. The subject does not need to be related to architecture. This could be a photo of an architectural model or something sculptural you have made, a drawing, a photograph, or another original work that shows your creative abilities.
3. One letter of recommendation from an instructor or advisor who is well-acquainted with your work.
4. Answer the following Yes/No question: Are you/will you be a first-generation college student?

Please email completed submission to exec@aiachatt.org by 5pm on Friday, June 17th. The scholarship committee of the AIA Chattanooga will review all qualifying applications before determining the recipients of the scholarship(s). Applicants will be notified via email on June 24, 2022.

The scholarship funds will be made payable to the summer architecture camp. The scholarship includes room and board during the week of camp but does not cover travel expenses to and from Knoxville.
